

Student Portrait Photo Self Submission- Due April 13th

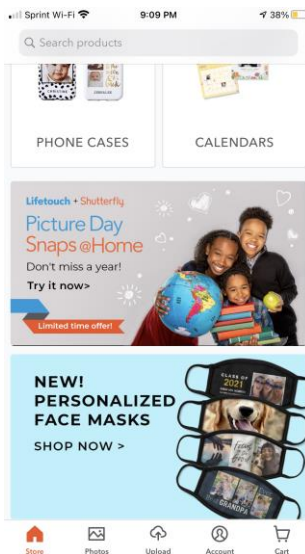
Great news! Even if your child did not participate in Picture Day, you can still have their photo included in the yearbook! You will need to submit a student portrait photo for each of your Cherry Crest student(s) by Tuesday April 13th. Use the guidelines below for the photo:

The best option is to use the **Picture Day Snaps @ Home** feature of the **Shutterfly** app. The photos produced by this app will be formatted correctly and will have a background applied automatically. IMPORTANT: The instructions on the webpage say that you must purchase a package, but **you do NOT have to purchase a package.**

Start the process and create a student portrait and add Snaps @ Home package to your shopping cart. Then click on Photos at the bottom of the app. You will see the student portrait that you created in the previous step. You can then save that file to your phone/computer and submit it to the yearbook.

When you install the app, you may need to scroll down quite far to find the link to the **Picture Day Snaps @Home** link.



If you choose not to use the Picture Day Snaps @Home app, use these guidelines to create your portrait.

- Photo should be at least 720 x 900 resolution
- Take the photo in portrait orientation
- Use a plain background, preferably blue
- Include only the student in the photo (no family, pets, etc)
- Try to fill the frame with the student's head and shoulders
